VOLUNTEER AT NATA 2023

AT EXPO PASSPORT CHALLENGE

SPECIAL ACCOMMODATIONS

The online registration process includes an opportunity for registrants to request assistance to be able to fully participate (mobility, hearing, vision, etc.) in official convention events. If requested, NATA staff will contact you for details.

STATEMENTS OF CREDIT

NATA provides statements of credit post-event. An email will be sent to all attendees eligible for CEUs, with instructions on how to access and print their statement of credit. This email will be sent by the end of July. It is the attendee's responsibility to check their statement of credit, upon receipt, to confirm it is accurate. **It is also the attendee's responsibility to report hours actually spent in the educational programming.** If you have a question about your statement, email ki@nata.org.

LAB EQUIPMENT SANITIZATION

Lysol will be used to sanitize lab equipment during Advanced Tracks and Learning Labs. Please use caution if you are sensitive to aerosol products.

CONVENTION ATTIRE

We strongly encourage participants to dress in a manner befitting professionals while attending educational events and the AT Expo. Business casual – shirts, slacks, skirts and blouses (no jeans or shorts) – is the recommended attire. Learning Lab participants should wear lab attire (something comfortable you can move freely in) and return to business casual afterwards.

Pro tip: You'll be doing a lot of walking, so be sure to pack comfortable shoes.

WEATHER

In June, daily high [temperatures in Indy](#) range from 78 to 84 degrees. Rain is always a possibility, so be sure to pack an umbrella – or you can buy one at the NATAGear store in Hall I!

RIBBONS

Most convention ribbons can be picked up at the Ribbon Bar in the Crossroads Corridor (across from the registration area) in ICC.

MOTHER'S ROOM

The Mother's Room is located in the women's restroom on the first floor of the ICC across from the Security Dispatch and First Aid offices along the Crossroads Corridor. The on-site lactation room provides privacy and may be accessed at any time. Each private area has a chair, electrical outlet, dimmable light and side table.

QUIET ROOM

Need a break from the action? Take a moment to rest and reflect in the Quiet Room, located on ICC Level 2 in Room 211.

AIRPORT TRANSPORTATION

Indianapolis Airport (IND) is located approximately 14 miles from ICC. Taxi fare is approximately \$36 from the airport to convention hotels. Taxi service is available at the curb on the lower level of the terminal just outside of baggage claim.

For Uber/Lyft/Other, estimates range between \$21 to \$37 one-way from the airport to convention hotels. To meet your ride service, head to the Ground Transportation Center on the first floor.

PARKING

[Parking](#) is available in garage and surface lots surrounding ICC.

PERSONAL SAFETY

Anytime you travel you should observe basic security precautions. Indy is no exception.

- ★ Travel in groups or pairs and try to stay in well-lit areas. ★ Be aware of your surroundings.
- ★ Wear your badge only at official NATA functions.

LOST AND FOUND

Stop by the NATA Info Desk in ICC Crossroads Corridor to turn in something you've found, or to see if your lost item has been turned in. Post-convention, email meetings1@nata.org.

WI-FI

Wireless internet is available in the food courts, corridors and public spaces for tasks that aren't bandwidth intensive such as reading email and light web browsing.

WATER

Water service is provided throughout ICC. Water fountains or coolers are located in the following corridors: Wabash East and West, Crossroads 1-2, Speedway 1-2, Hoosier 1-2.
